Protect Yourself from Social Security Scams

Scammers are pretending to be government employees. Scammers will try to scare and trick you into giving them your personal information and money. They may threaten you or your family and may demand immediate payment to avoid arrest or other legal action.

**DON'T BE FOOLED!
IF YOU RECEIVE A SUSPICIOUS CALL:**

1. Hang up!
2. **DO NOT** give them money or personal information!
3. Report the scam at [OIG.SSA.GOV!](https://www.oig.ssa.gov)



Social Security may call you in some situations but will never

- Threaten you
- Suspend your Social Security Number
- Demand immediate payment from you
- Require payment by cash, gift card, pre-paid debit card, or wire transfer
- Ask for gift card numbers over the phone or to wire or mail cash

What to look out for



The call or email says there is a problem with your Social Security Number or account.



Someone asking you to pay a fine or debt with retail gift cards, wire transfers, pre-paid debit cards, internet currency, or by mailing cash.



Scammers pretend they're from Social Security or another government agency. Caller ID or documents sent by email may look official but they are not.



Callers threaten you with arrest or other legal action.

LOCKOUT / TAGOUT FOR LIFE

The only way to your safety when servicing, maintaining and unjamming equipment is to control the hazardous energy sources present in machinery. Put it under lock and key or lockout / tagout (LOTO).

LOTO AUTHORIZED EMPLOYEES MUST LOTO WHEN:

1. A safety device such as a guard or a door is removed or bypassed.
2. Cleaning a machine.
3. Servicing or repairing a component within a machine.
4. Any part of the body is placed where it could be caught by moving machinery.

SERVICE AND MAINTENANCE OF EQUIPMENT IS A HIGH RISK ACTIVITY

Lives or limbs can be lost if LOTO is not done properly. When in doubt, lock it out! Your family is counting on you!

LOTO AUTHORIZED EMPLOYEES: 6 STEPS TO LOTO

1. **Plan and prepare for shutdown.** Think before taking action. Inform all affected employees of the LOTO plan.
2. **Shut down the equipment.** Put the equipment at its normal, at-rest position.
3. **Isolate the equipment.** Separate from external energy sources.
4. **Apply LOTO devices.** Attach your lock, tag and hasp to the energy- isolating device to prevent the flow of energy to the machine. If you are working with multiple people on equipment, EACH PERSON must place a lock and tag on the energy isolation point.
5. **Control stored energy.** Discharge or control any energy stored in the equipment.
6. **Verify isolation: Zero energy.** Test to make sure the right system has been locked out and cannot be operated. Verify isolation periodically until work is completed.

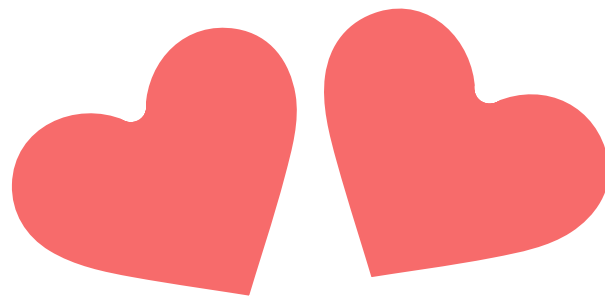
